



Background

National Safai Karamcharis Finance & Development Corporation (NSKFDC) is a wholly owned Govt. of India Undertaking under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, set up on 24th January 1997 as a Company "Not for Profit" under Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013. It is in operation since October, 1997, as an Apex Corporation for the all round socio-economic upliftment of the Safai Karamcharis (including wastepickers), Manual Scavengers and their dependants throughout the Country through its various loan and non-loan based schemes. The loan schemes are implemented through State Channelizing Agencies (SCAs) nominated by the State Govts./UTs/Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) & Public Sector Banks (PSBs) and Skill Development Training Programmes (SDTP) are implemented through Govt. Sector Training Institutions across the Country.



"manual scavenger" means a person engaged or employed, at the commencement of this Act or at any time thereafter, by an individual or a local authority or an agency or a contractor, for manually cleaning, carrying, disposing of, or otherwise handling in any manner, human excreta in an insanitary latrine or in an open drain or pit into which human excreta from the insanitary latrines is disposed of, or on a railway track or in such other spaces or premises, as the Central Government or a State Government may notify, before the excreta fully decomposes in such manner as may be prescribed, and the expression "manual scavenging" shall be construed accordingly;

Any District where 'manual scavenging' as per above definition is not in practice may become 'manual scavenging free'.


